

# Performance Monitoring and Reporting Table

Questions to Consider	Example Response*	Response
<p><b>“How do we share performance data back to partners in a timely manner for collaborative interpretation of findings?”</b></p>	<p>Data will be tracked electronically and will be presented to partners in monthly PHAST meetings.</p>	
<p><b>“Based on the measurement data, how are we doing?”</b></p>	<p>Determine based on performance measures and targets established.</p>	
<p><b>“Were there any unintended consequences?”</b></p>	<p>Determine based on key informant interviews and/or regular monitoring and discussion of unforeseen events, incidents, and outcomes.</p>	
<p><b>“Who is benefiting from this intervention? Who is being missed? Is everyone receiving the same opportunities or quality of service offered through this intervention or is there variation by race, age group, gender, or other demographic characteristics?”</b></p>	<p>Determine based on demographic data collected.</p>	
<p><b>“What feedback have we received from front-line staff and people directly and indirectly impacted by this change?”</b></p>	<p>Determine based on qualitative data collected through informal conversations with police officers.</p>
